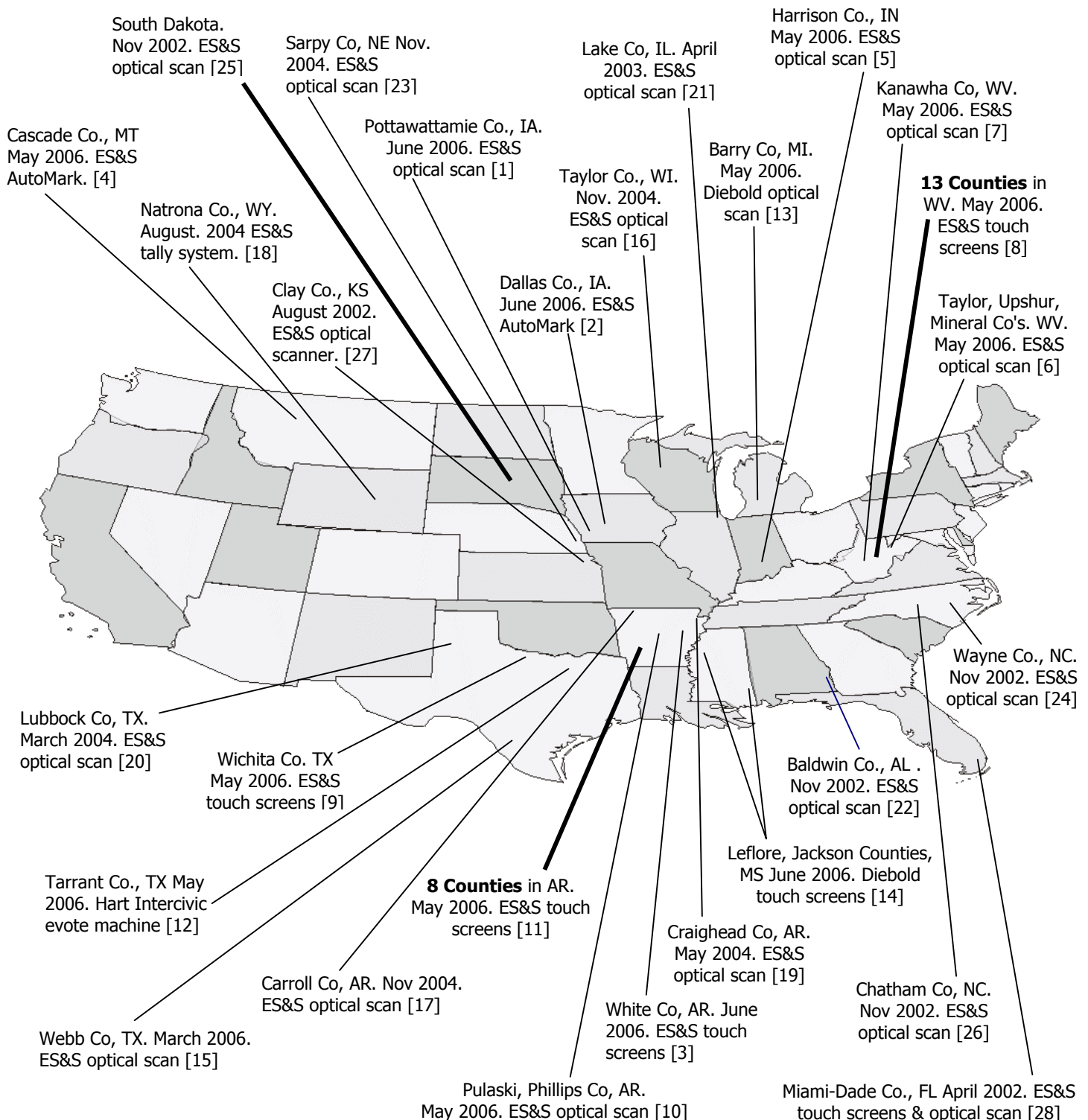


Vote-Switching Software Provided by Vendors
