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- 3. Mr. Harris told Mr. Sivley and me that he would prepare the notice of removal.
- 4. I later had a conversation with Mr. Harris wherein he indicated that, essentially as a convenience to us, he could simply prepare the joinder in the notice of removal for the county if we would authorize him to sign for us. I discussed this matter with Gordon Sivley and he agreed that this approach was acceptable with him and I should so advise Mr. Harris, which I did.

 he did so with both Mr. Sivley's and my full knowledge and express authority.
- 6. As per the above, Snohomish County, by and through its attorneys Mr. Sivley and I, consents to the removal of this matter to federal court and has consistently done so since co-defendant Sequoia first removed this action formally.
